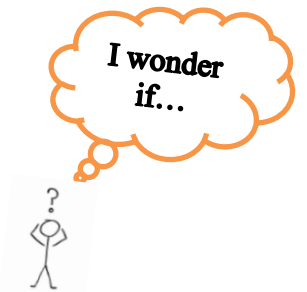


How do you know if you're ready for an online class?



Here are 2 quizzes I found online that will give you some idea of how well-suited you are for an online class. Don't cheat yourself into thinking that you can handle an online class. Online classes are reading intense and require a great deal of self-discipline. Online classes are more difficult than face-to-face classes. You may be better served by taking a 'live' course – not an online course. The quizzes are scored immediately. Based on the scores, recommendations are made to continue with the course or consult with your teacher. Taking a 'live' class is always an option.
